Definition of novice stake:	Novice is confined to dogs that have not gained a 1 st , 2 nd , or 3 rd in open stakes or a 1 st in an all-aged or novice stake.	
Definition of open stake	A Stake in which dogs have the opportunity of gaining a qualification towards the title. Field Trial Champion and towards entry in the Championship Stake of its breed.	
Qualification	Preference in the draw will be given to fully paid-up members

Conditions of entry:	<p>We will follow Government guidelines re Covid-19, Avian Influenza and Kennel Club directives to include in the risk assessment.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. 2) The Club reserves the right to accept or refuse entries. 3) Reserves will be approached in strict order. If a reserve cannot be contacted despite all efforts, the next reserve will be offered the run. This decision will stand even if the original reserve appears at the Trial. No substitution of dogs will be allowed whilst reserves still stand. 4) All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number, before entry to the event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number, will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor. 5) If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot. 6) Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club. 7) No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries. 8) Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership. 9) Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the host. 10) Welfare of dogs - A competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any field trial licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the trial. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations 11) Dogs in cars on hot days - Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused. 12) For withdrawals K.C. regulation J6 applies. Withdrawals will not be accepted by text, email or messenger services, telephone the secretary only 13) All persons attending these Trials must consider themselves under the control of the Chief Steward. The Club accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to persons or property however occasioned. 14) Directions will be sent out with the result of the draw. Loss of armband incurs a £5 fine. Unused cheques will be destroyed
